

Advisory Committee Application and Commitment

I hereby apply to serve on the Advisory Committee of the Nevada Natural Resource Education Council, whose purpose is to advise the Board of Directors on the activities and focus of the organization.

I commit to attending at least one meeting of the committee during the coming year. At least two meetings will be held per year. One meeting will be held during the NNREC statewide conference. Other meetings will be held at other times and may be held in different population centers of the state in order to gather information from the geographically distinct parts of the state. The date and location of the meeting during the conference will be provided to committee members at least six months in advance. The date and location of other meetings will be provided at least three weeks in advance, and may be set much further in advance.

I commit to keeping in touch with the committee and any subcommittees of which I become a member via email during the remainder of the year. Subcommittees may be formed which will investigate topics in more depth or gather information from outside the committee in order that the committee as a whole may provide the best advice to the board. The subcommittees may meet in person, or by conference call, or may exchange information by email and mail.

The committee may also become involved in implementing recommendations they have made which have been accepted by the Board of Directors, including but not limited to, fundraising, outreach, awards, policy development, and conference planning. I am not making any specific commitment to these activities at this time.

Each meeting of the committee will be facilitated by a member of the committee. This is an opportunity for professional leadership and challenge for you. Though one or more members of the Board of Directors attend each meeting, the committee is lead by its members and makes decisions by consensus.

The Board of Directors of NNREC commits to careful consideration of each recommendation of the Advisory Committee and may also use the content of discussions, which did not result in a decision or recommendation, in its deliberations.

Membership in NNREC is not required to participate in the Advisory Committee, but is certainly welcome.
