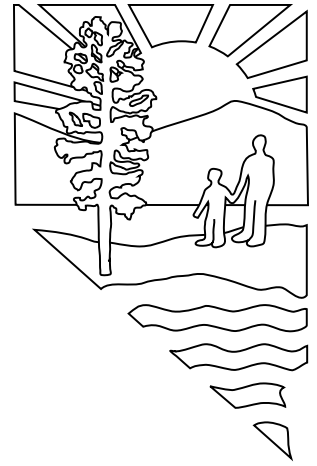

Nevada Natural Resource Education Council (NNREC) is pleased to submit this FY 2007 Nevada Recreational Trails Educational Grant Application for a project titled Summer Wilderness Experiences for Teens. The project includes program staff labor costs, staff training, and backpacking equipment purchase. NNREC is working with a wide variety of partners who are already planning summer programs so that they can include staff resources, appropriate trail maintenance and safety-related training for staff, and backcountry equipment in their programs.

The project is in compliance with Section 1302 (e)(2)(c) of the National Recreational Trails Act that prohibits the use of grant funds to accommodate motorized use on trails that have been predominately used by non-motorized trail users and on which, as of May 1, 1991, motorized use is either prohibited or has not occurred. This project does not include construction of new trails crossing federal land. All trail maintenance projects will be cleared with the appropriate land management agency (Forest Service, Nevada Division of State Parks, Bureau of Land Management).

NNREC is a Nevada Nonprofit Corporation and Federal 501(c)3 Education and Public Benefit Corporation.
