## Great Basin Outdoor School at Lake Tahoe seeks Naturalists & Program Director for Fall 2007

Teach local ecology and activities to develop a sense of community and connection to the natural world on the shore of beautiful Lake Tahoe. Present a hands-on, experiential, inquiry-based program in earth sciences, astronomy, and water, wildlife and forest ecology, based on GBOS curriculum and state and national education standards. Integrate other subject areas, community-building challenges, service learning projects, and commitment to stewardship and protection of the environment. Enjoy panoramic view of Tahoe from three-story staff home. Two to three classes of fifth and sixth graders stay Tuesday through Friday and will be divided into study groups of 12-15. Learn Tahoe ecology aboard a 45' Tahoe research vessel. Teach four-day weeks of approximately 40 hours each.

**Fall:** September 4 - October 25 at Camp Galilee, Lake Tahoe; Program Director works additional time before and after seasonal program.

**Qualifications:** Residential outdoor school experience preferred, strong communication and interpersonal skills, natural history background, college degree preferably in education or the natural sciences, first aid, CPR, background check. Campfire skills (song leading, guitar, story telling) desirable. Enthusiasm!
